

BASIS Baton Rouge Mid City Special Education Advisory Council Report SY2022-2023

This document provides a summary of the activities undertaken by the BASIS Baton Rouge Mid City Primary Campus Special Education Advisory Council (SEAC) during the 2022-2023 school year. The BASIS Baton Rouge Mid City SEAC held meetings on the following dates:

- December 7, 2022
- March 8, 2023
- May 10, 2023

During each meeting, the BASIS Baton Rough Mid City school leadership provided an overview of the current population of students with disabilities currently enrolled at the school, and provided updates regarding any relevant staffing changes throughout the school year. Additional SEAC activities included:

- Developing an onboarding/welcoming system for students with disabilities and their parents when enrolling at BASIS Baton Rouge Mid City;
- Hosting an Open House event for new parents of students with disabilities that will allow parents the opportunity to meet school staff and address any parent questions;
- Providing feedback to school leadership regarding new staff onboarding that occurs throughout the school year;
- Providing feedback to school leadership regarding communication best practices between parents and school staff;
- Proposing an initiative to add sensory playground equipment to the school campus;
- Instituting a parent group focused on family health and wellness;
- Collaborating with the Booster Club to develop various parent workshops;
- Developing an online social group for parents to aid in communication and growing community within the school; and
- Soliciting new SEAC parent members to expand the council.
