

BASIS Baton Rouge Mid City Special Education Advisory Council Report SY2023-2024

This document provides a summary of the activities undertaken by the BASIS Baton Rouge Mid City Primary Campus Special Education Advisory Council (SEAC) during the 2023-2024 school year. The BASIS Baton Rouge Mid City SEAC held meetings on the following dates:

- December 12, 2023
- March 26, 2024
- May 1, 2024

During each meeting, the BASIS Baton Rouge Mid City school leadership provided an overview of the current population of students with disabilities currently enrolled at the school, and provided updates regarding any relevant staffing changes throughout the school year. Additional SEAC activities included:

- Discussion of support needed from EBR PAS to help families in the evaluation process;
- Developing an onboarding/welcoming system for students with disabilities and their parents when enrolling at BASIS Baton Rouge Mid City;
- Providing a special hour at Back to School Night for new parents of students with disabilities that will allow parents and students the opportunity to meet school staff;
- Discussion of sending home a one page informational sheet with Trimester One progress reports with any student who is suspected to need additional support;
- Discussion of creating a sensory walk outside for all students to use when overwhelmed or in need of a cool down period;
- Proposing an initiative to add a sensory room to the campus;
- Collaborating with the Booster Club to develop a parent liaison for families in need of additional support; and
- Inviting new parents to become members of the SEAC.
