

BASIS Baton Rouge Mid City Special Education Advisory Council Report

Meeting Topics Addressed

- BASIS has established new service arrangements to secure qualified providers for related services such as speech-language therapy, occupational therapy, and behavioral supports. Our regional Special Education Coordinator has been introduced and will serve as the primary point of contact for program oversight, compliance monitoring, and coordination with families and school teams.
- The school remains committed to the student identification process: teachers and staff will use district screening tools and referral procedures to identify students who may need special education evaluation; the SBLC Team will review referrals within ten school days and determine whether RTI processes should begin or if there are other supports that can be immediately put in place to support a student. If a formal evaluation is warranted, timely assessments will be scheduled by the Special Education Coordinator and completed by qualified evaluators; Individualized Education Program (IEP) meetings will be convened to review assessment results and develop appropriate services. The school will document placements, service provider assignments, and timelines to ensure continuity of services during the transition.
- Plans for compensatory services to address lapses caused by disruptions in secured service providers have been created and discussed with families
